Summer Leadership Adventure Camp

(07th May 2008 ~ 09th May 2008)

Summer Leadership Adventure Camp was conducted by Prayag Discovery Village, in association with Woody's Adventure. The Instructors of this Camp were Mr. Asher & Ms. Roohi (Prayag Discovery Village) accompanied by Mr. Pradeep & Mr. Shiva (Woody's Adventure).

Day 1 [07th May 2008]

It was a bright summer morning on 07th May 2008, the day children started off with their three day Summer Leadership Adventure Camp. The children were picked up from Banashankari Temple at 07.15 am. Soon our journey started towards Mutturayanbetta, where children were provided a good healthy south Indian breakfast.

As per schedule, 1st Day of camp started off with the Trekking Mutturayanbetta located close to Prayag Discovery Village. Children trekked upto a height of 300ft and on the way did encounter a few rock lizards. Once they reached their destination they were taken to a pre-located cave and were taught the nuance of cave exploration. It was a wonderful experience for these children as they crawled with their torches on & they were more surprised to find bats in the cave while exploring.



After their cave-exploration and trekking they got back to our base camp-Prayag discovery Village.

They assemble back at 08.30 am at the play ground for their activities like 'Brick Game', 'Skis', 'Rope activity' & 'Obstacle course'. After which they were served lunch & were given some time to rest and mingle with their new friends.

Later children got back to activities at 03.30 pm for game 'Trust fall' at play area. As per the schedule they were to be show how to pitch

a tent but due to rain playing spoil sport it was put off, and also due to popular demand the children jumped into the pool.

For the evening they were given an assignment to write, direct & perform a play with their 2 days of learning as a whole group. As usual at 08.30 pm children served food. Children had lunch around 1.30 p.m and wanted the organizers to extend the camp for a day but their parents were already waiting for them in Bangalore. So they had to get back to their rooms and pack their bags as the departure time was set at 4.30.
