Activities outside the house

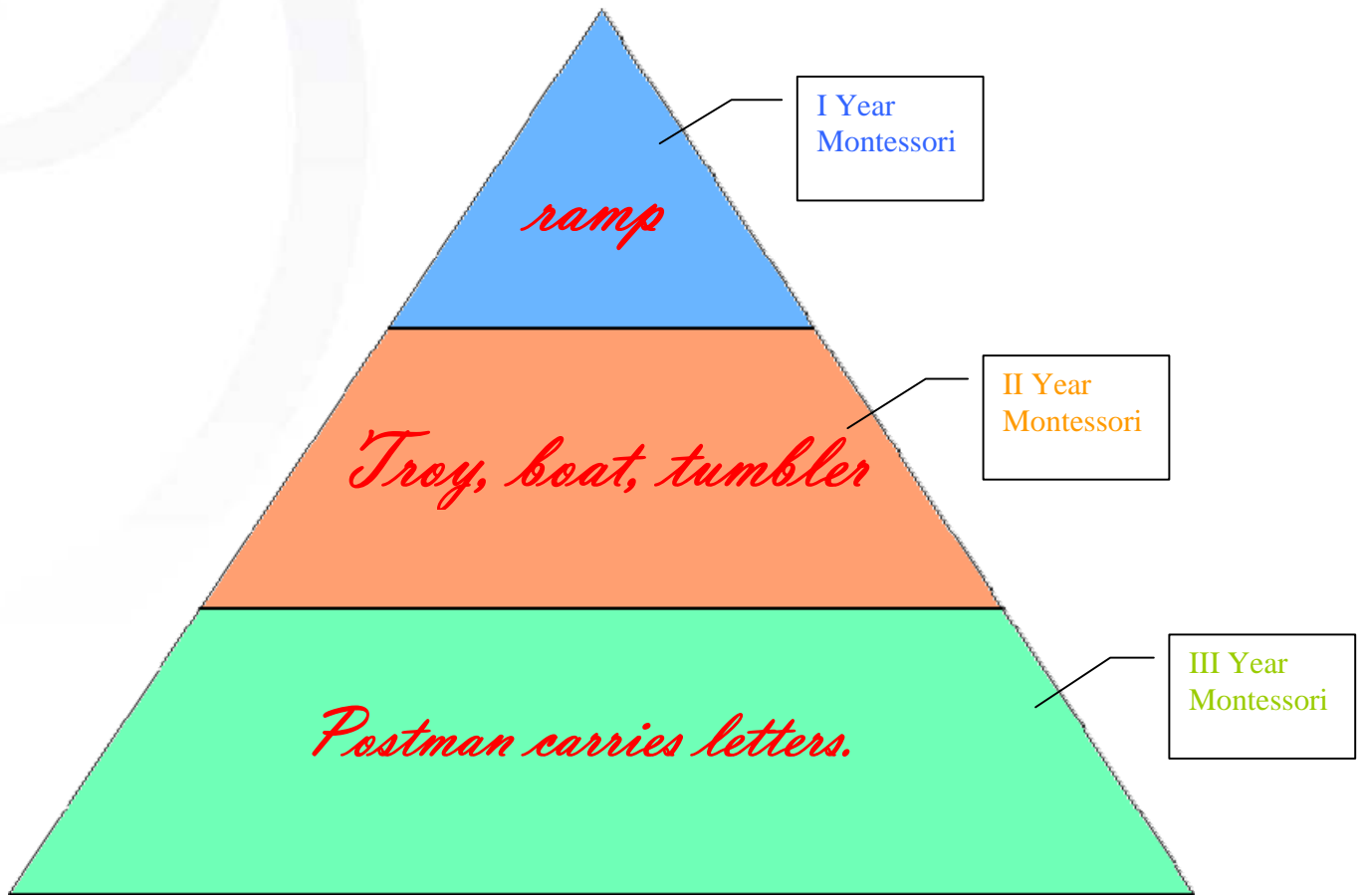
